

Learning situation 2 – Cooperation and communication development by learning activity

In a second-grade class, the teacher gives students a group task. Using picture cards, the groups create a short story. Each group consists of four students. They receive different pictures (for example: park, dog, ball, rainy day, playground). Their task is to invent a story together and arrange the pictures in the correct sequence. The teacher encourages students to listen to each other's ideas, make joint decisions, and ensure that everyone participates. In one group, two students speak very actively, while a third student struggles to contribute. Meanwhile, the fourth student tries to arrange the pictures, but the group members cannot agree on the correct order. The teacher approaches the group and asks: “*What could you do to make sure everyone can share their ideas?*” After a short discussion, the students decide that they will share their ideas one by one.
